A Letter From Our Founders

Positive change doesn't happen by chance - it is sought out by courage, cultivated through advocacy, and supported by the community. Every survivor who gets to a place of independence is better positioned to protect their children. It fills our cup to know there are 620 kiddos out there dreaming bigger because their mom's redefined resilience.

The work is not just about surviving hardship - it's about creating the life of your choosing. It's about the survivor who earned a CNA certification and, with access to reliable transportation, expanded her job search radius to maximize her wages. Today, she is a nursing assistant in a hospital, with a steady salary, benefits, and a path toward becoming an LPN. "I wouldn't have been able to do what I did without the help with expenses and an advocate providing direction," she told us.

It's about the mother who, despite a history of bad credit, worked with her advocate to find stable housing for her family. We covered the security deposit and provided a reference; she is now building credit for the future with an apartment in her name. In her words: "I can finally sleep at night."

These are not stories. These are lives changed. Futures reclaimed. And they are made possible because this community refuses to allow systemic barriers to define people's futures.

As we look ahead, we remain committed to pushing boundaries, building partnership, and ensuring that survivors have the opportunities they need to thrive.

Thank you for being part of this journey with us.

80% of human trafficking survivors in the U.S. are
revictimized. When survivors go through Empowered
Network, that number is under 1%.

Communities spend a projected \$5.3 million on every
survivor trapped in the system. But that's nothing
compared to what it costs them: their future.

Community Impact.

When a survivor dismantles generational poverty and
exploitation cycles, the community no longer needs to fund
service and system support. When looked at collectively,
Empowered Network's economic mobility program has an
exponential impact on capacity and resources available
within the entire philanthropic system.

The average wage increase of participants is greater
than the cost of the program per member—
a compelling benefit statement for the local economy!

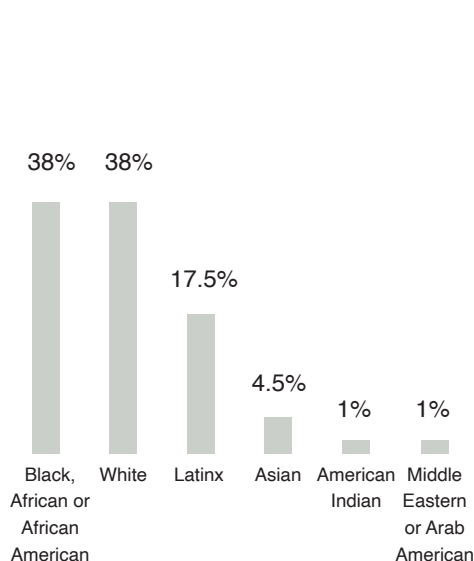

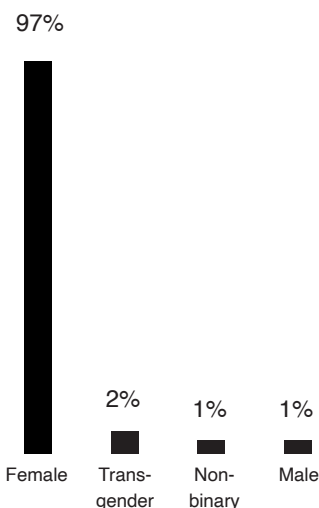


Empower Who?

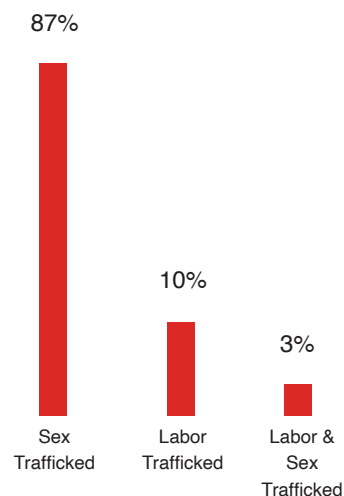

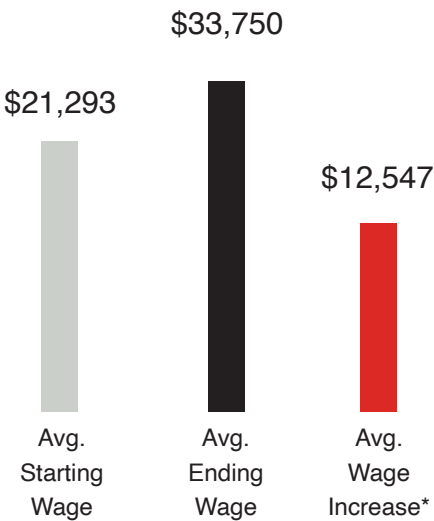
Claiming Stability, Cultivating Strength: 2024 Impact

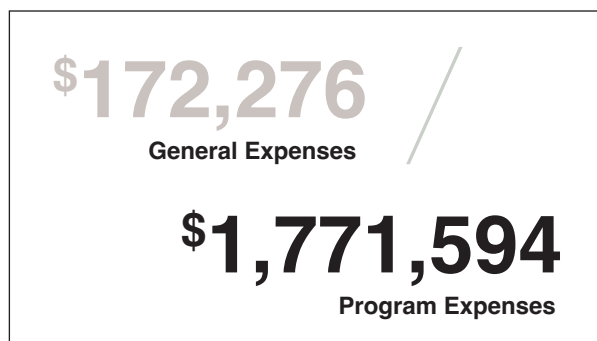
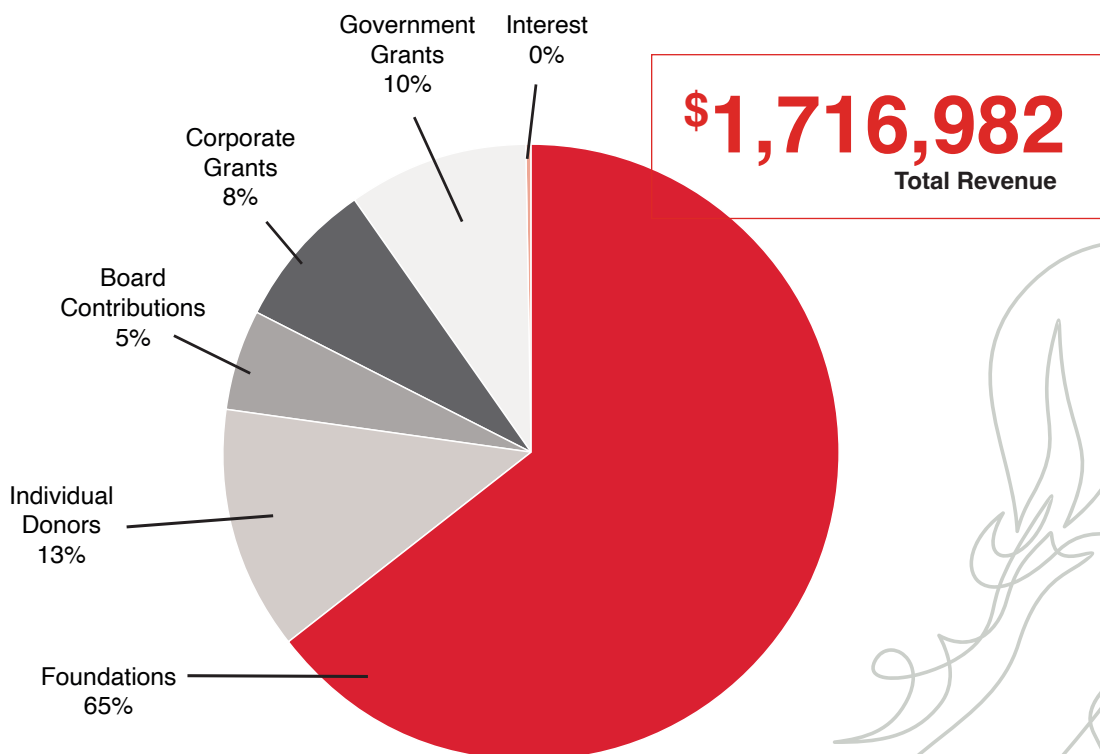
